# From the Pastor

## NEW RETREAT CENTER

Work has begun on a new retreat center on our property at 1784 Cannonville Road. A road has been graded, parking has taken shape, and a lawn and pad for the new pavilion and restrooms has been put into place.

The Troup County Planning Commission has given us a "Special Use Permit" to develop our property. The county commissioners then voted in favor of our request. Both boards voted 100% in our favor.

The Troup County Planning commission will use our project as a prototype for other congregations in the county that become involved in similar development projects. The name of this property on our special use permit and other permits is "Lloyd Presbyterian Youth Nature Retreat."

A water meter has been installed and a water line will soon be run. Electrical lines (underground) will follow.

The driveway will be 12 feet wide with a shoulder on each side. The pavilion will be 30 x 60 with a separate restroom building at one end. Each restroom will have 2 stalls, with one being handicap accessible. There will also be a storage building at one end. Nature trails take off from the pavilion site.

I toured the area under construction with Terry Baker and was very impressed with how beautiful the property is. The pavilion will be located well away from the road so that noise from the highway will be non-existent.

In this newsletter is also a map of the property showing the driveway, pavilion area, and nature trails. See page 5.

I believe that as we move forward as a congregation and grow both spiritually and numerically, this property will play an important role in the ministries of our congregation in the future.

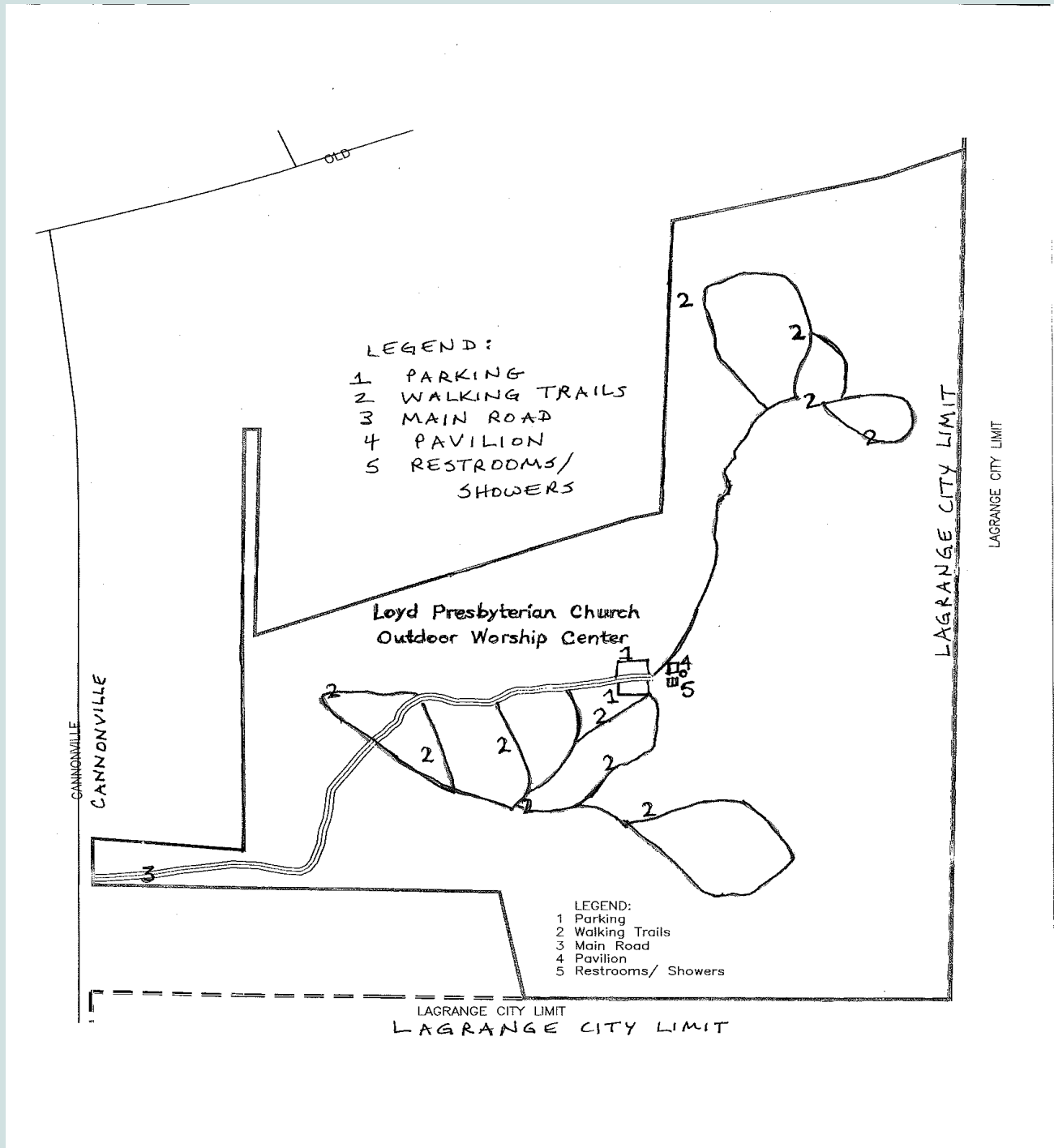
### **SPECIAL FINANCIAL REPORT:**
