Would you spend two hours to save a life?

Suicide continues to be a dilemma for our community with Georgia ranking 12th in the nation for death by suicide. Since COVID19, rates have increased, with some areas seeing triple the amount of suicides compared to this time last year. The QPR Institute offers an evidence- based suicide prevention course that strives to educate the public in order to help save lives. The primary objectives are to train participants to understand the nature and range of suicidal communications and how to intervene on behalf of suicidal and in-crisis people.

- · Make referrals to local professionals



QPR stands for "Question, Persuade, Refer" and it is a suicide prevention initiative relying on evidence-based practices to respond to individuals in crisis.

Suicide is a growing issue and addressing it means understanding how we can help. Topics like suicide are not easy to discuss and become even harder when they have personally affected you, your family, or friends. But issues don't go away because we refuse to talk about them or try to ignore the statistics. With greater information, we might be a resource to an individual in crisis. 

A Core 13 Update:


