### A Brief Message from Tyler:

This coming Sunday is Mother's Day, and we will be celebrating with a breakfast that morning at 9am. When the church has a Sunday which overlaps with a date on the calendar in the secular world, it represents a rather interesting conundrum. That is, how do you ensure that you honor God through worship without making the service totally about the holiday? It happens when a Sunday falls on July 4th, Cinco de Mayo, Halloween, etc.

The obvious answer is the mothers of scripture, such as Sarah, Leah, Rachel, or Mary. These mother's stories are not always pleasant tales. There are the midwives Shiphrah and Puah, the midwives who saved the Israelites from the Egyptian plan to get rid of male babies. the Bible offers stories that could be celebrated in worship.

There is another option of tying together the faith that we have been taught by the mothers in our lives who pressed us to be a part of the church and the Christian faith. For me, that is absolutely something that rings true. I was always at church on Sunday, whether by dragging, bribing, or choice. I would not be where I am without a mother who was deeply involved with church.

At the same time, Mother's Day creates the opportunity of missing the greater struggle of this day for those individuals who did not have a loving mother, who are struggling to become a mother, who are mothers by choice and not by birth, and a whole host of scenarios.

There might not be a perfect answer; on this coming Sunday, we will celebrate with all those individuals who were mothers in our lives: the ones who loved us, who chose us, who we call "mom," and all those people that were mothers to us somehow. Additionally, we will celebrate all the women who are mothers for others, biologic or otherwise. We will celebrate the women who are trying to become a mother but haven't realized that dream yet. We will celebrate the ones who are content to be pet moms.
